**NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR THE REGISTRATION OF LAND AS A VILLAGE GREEN**

Application has been made to the Registration Authority, Kent County Council, by the Hoath Parish Council under section 15(8) of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014. The application seeks the inclusion in the Register of Town and Village Greens of the land described in the Schedule below. If the Registration Authority is satisfied that the land described below qualifies for registration as a Town or Village Green, it will so register the land.

**Representations must include the name and postal address of the person making them and the nature of their interest (if any) in the land affected by the application. They must also be signed by the person making them and state the grounds on which they are made.**

Please note that any representations that are to be taken into account by the Registration Authority in reaching a decision on the application cannot be treated as confidential and may come into the public domain during the processing of the application. Copies of any objections or representations received will be forwarded to the applicant for comment and may be disclosed to other interested parties, including the Planning Inspectorate where the case is referred to it for determination.

**Description of the land claimed to have qualified for registration as a Village Green**

A parcel of land of approximately 0.8 acre (0.32 hectares) in size situated opposite Hoath Primary School (and on the northern side of Marley Fields) in the village of Hoath, near Canterbury.
